This prize will be given to to one young investigator in recognition of his/her excellence in the field of structures and functions of bioactive and biogenic substances, molecular mechanisms with biological and medical implications, as well as biomaterials and their applications. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Dr. Vladimir N. Uversky.

### The Prizes:

- 2000 CHF (Swiss Francs);
- The opportunity to publish one paper free of charge in *Biomolecules* after peer review before the end of 31 December 2023;
- Certificate.

# **Eligibility and Requirements:**

- Must have a Ph.D. degree;
- Must be 35 years of age or below by 31 December 2022;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of structures and functions of bioactive and biogenic substances, molecular mechanisms with biological and medical implications, as well as biomaterials and their applications;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

# **List of Documents for Nomination:**

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

- Open for nominations: 25 February 2022
- Nomination deadline: 30 September 2022
- Winner announcement: 30 November 2022
