Eligibility and Requirements:

- Hold an earned Ph.D. or M.D. degree.
- Be 40 years age or under (as of 31 December 2018).
- Conduct ground-breaking research, making a significant contribution to the advancement of cancer research.
- Priority will be given to applicants who have published papers in Cancers.

List of Documents for Nominations:

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's research grants.
- List of conferences the candidate will attend (the conference name and its website).
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate.
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

The award will consist of:

- 2000 Swiss Francs.
- An offer to publish a paper free of charge without a fixed deadline in Cancers after peer review.
- An engraved plaque.
