Means of Improving Gastric Cancer Response to Chemotherapy and Immunotherapy

Message from the Guest Editors

Gastric cancer remains a major global health burden and despite advances in chemotherapy and immunotherapy, treatment response varies widely among patients. Therefore, identifying strategies to improve therapeutic response while maintaining safety and quality of life is an urgent clinical challenge.

Topics of interest include, but are not limited to, management of adverse events affecting treatment continuity, biomarkers predicting resistance and strategies to improve adherence to oral anticancer agents. Particular attention is given to real-world clinical research, pharmacist-led interventions and supportive care measures that enable patients to maintain treatment intensity and duration.

In addition, this Special Issue welcomes studies on immunotherapy-related adverse event management, combination strategies integrating chemotherapy and immunotherapy and innovative approaches to personalize treatment based on patient characteristics. By integrating clinical oncology, oncology pharmacy and supportive care perspectives, this Special Issue aims to provide practical insights that translate into improved treatment outcomes for patients with gastric cancer.
