We are pleased to announce that *Chemosensors* is now inviting nominations for the *Chemosensors* 2022 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be awarded to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of chemical sensors and related analytical methods and systems. All nominations will be assessed by an award committee led by the Editor-in-Chief Prof. Dr. Nicole Jaffrezic-Renault.

The Prize:

- CHF 1000 (Swiss Francs);
- Option to publish one paper, free of charge, in *Chemosensors* before the end of December 2023, following peer review;
- A certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2022:
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of chemical sensors and related analytical methods and systems;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

Open for nominations: 25 May 2022; Nomination deadline: 31 December 2022; Winner announcement: 28 February 2023.
