The field of Developmental Pediatrics emphasizes early identification, advocacy, and intervention to optimize the functional neurodevelopmental outcomes of children with a myriad of potential challenges. With advances in the biological underpinnings of neurodevelopmental disabilities, further subspecialization within the field has emerged. This new frontier explores genetic underpinnings, articulates developmental phenotypes with greater granularity, examines dual diagnoses, and evaluates intervention efficacy.
