The former is a recent research field being explored with output-level and latent representation-level techniques. The latter is more consolidated in the literature, and his work is aimed at enriching neural network capabilities using self-training strategies based on generated pseudo-labels. Mr. Umberto Michieli would like to attend International Conference on Computer Vision (ICCV) 2021, Montreal, Canada, 11–17 October 2021. The award consists of 800 Swiss Francs to attend this conference.
