# Advanced Diagnostics in Women's Health: From Biomarkers to Imaging

### Message from the Guest Editor

The Special Issue aims to bring together innovative research on modern diagnostic approaches integrating molecular biomarkers, laboratory parameters, and advanced imaging techniques across the spectrum of gynaecological and obstetrical conditions.

Recent progress in laboratory medicine has introduced a wide range of biomarkers reflecting inflammatory, metabolic, hormonal, and vascular processes, which may improve early diagnosis and prognostic evaluation in disorders such as hypertensive complications of pregnancy, endometriosis, gynaecologic malignancies, and reproductive disorders. At the same time, developments in non-invasive imaging methods, including high-resolution ultrasound, Doppler techniques, MRI, and multimodal imaging, have enhanced the accuracy and reproducibility of diagnostic evaluation in both obstetrics and gynaecology.

By promoting interdisciplinary contributions from clinicians, laboratory scientists, and imaging specialists, this Special Issue aims to provide a comprehensive overview of state-of-the-art diagnostic methods and their role in advancing precision medicine in women's health.
