Message from the Guest Editor

Head and neck cancer (HNC) management is incredibly challenging, and despite innovation in radiation oncology and immunotherapy introduction in the metastatic setting, the prognosis in the recurrent metastatic HNC is dismal. The current standard treatment for locally advanced HNC has remained unchanged for 20 years. A multidisciplinary network and the expertise of each specialist affect outcome in such patients. A proper classification and diagnosis of HNC and the selection of adequate biomarkers, both predictive and prognostic, might change the future of HNC management, which at the moment is dated, not personalized, and based on agnostic approaches.
