Sudden cardiac death is a relevant problem, affecting populations of all ages, including the young, and in 50% of cases, it may be the first manifestation of the disease. The latest scientific evidence emphasizes the importance of multiparametric and multidisciplinary evaluation in the arrhythmic risk stratification of the patient with cardiomyopathy, highlighting the increasingly important role of cardiac magnetic resonance imaging and genetics.
