Complex and severe allergic conditions present significant diagnostic difficulties, often leading to delays in accurate diagnosis and appropriate management. While classic allergies are frequently recognizable, conditions such as severe anaphylaxis with atypical presentations, eosinophilic granulomatosis with polyangiitis (EGPA), and pollen food allergy syndrome (PFS) pose unique challenges.
