# Diagnosis and Management of Liver Diseases and Inflammatory Bowel Diseases

### Message from the Guest Editors

The global burden of liver and inflammatory bowel diseases is on the rise. Although complex pathophysiological mechanisms of various liver disorders as well as inflammatory bowel disease have been elucidated, morbidity is still high. Although breakthroughs in diagnosing metabolic-dysfunction-associated steatosis liver disease, primary sclerosing cholangitis, primary biliary cholangitis, hepatitis B and C, and autoimmune hepatitis have been made in recent decades, the adequate timing of diagnosis, and hence treatment, still remains a clinical challenge. Taking into consideration that liver disease in some cases may accompany inflammatory bowel disease, it is of great importance to diagnose both conditions properly so that the management of these diseases can commence in a timely and adequate manner. In this Special Issue, new, original research articles and reviews regarding the diagnosis and management of liver and inflammatory bowel diseases, as well as complications and special conditions related to these diseases, will be considered for publication.
