Despite innovations in radiation oncology and immunotherapy introduction in the metastatic setting, prognosis in recurrent metastatic head and neck cancer is dismal. A proper classification and diagnosis of HND and the selection of adequate biomarkers, both predictive and prognostic, might change the future of HND management, which is currently dated, not personalized, and based on agnostic approaches.
