Consequently, Disabilities is inclusive of all types of disability, across all ages and contexts. We particularly welcome articles from low- and middle- income countries and articles that are authored/co-authored by people with the lived experience of disabilities.

Author Benefits

Open Access: free for readers, with <u>article processing charges (APC)</u> paid by authors or their institutions.

High Visibility: indexed within ESCI (Web of Science), Scopus, EBSCO, and other databases.

Rapid Publication: manuscripts are peer-reviewed and a first decision is provided to authors approximately 50.2 days after submission; acceptance to publication is undertaken in 6.1 days (median values for papers published in this journal in the first half of 2025).
