## Message from the Guest Editor

This Special Issue of Economies, titled "Digital Banking, Financial Inclusion, and Age at Risk", focuses on the intersection of technological innovation in finance and the challenges of inclusive access across age groups. Its central focus is on how the rapid shift toward digital banking can foster or hinder financial inclusion. particularly for vulnerable populations such as older adults and younger cohorts who may face distinct barriers.
