## AVARDS FOR POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS

## **Candidates' Requirements:**

- The postdoctoral fellow (within four years of receiving their PhD degree) should undertake their research within the scope of *Electronics*.
- The postdoctoral fellow will attend an international conference in 2019 (oral presentation or poster). Preference will be given to oral presentations accompanied by a published paper in the conference proceedings.
- The awardees are asked to acknowledge the support from the journal of Electronics in their published papers or posters.

## **Required Application Documents:**

- The applicant's oral or poster abstract for the conference (list the conference name and its website).
- CV, including a complete list of publications.
- A justification letter (a maximum of 500 words) describing the focus of their research, and what benefits the applicant could get from attending the conference.
- A letter of recommendation (a maximum of 400 words) from a supervisor or principal investigator (PI). The supervisor or PI should sign and confirm that the applicant fulfills all of the requirements.
