Eligibility and Requirements of the Candidates:

- Must have received a PhD degree within the past 10 years within the scope of Electronics (http://www.mdpi.com/journal/electronics/about).
- Must be 40 years of age or under (as of 31 December 2018).

List of Documents Needed for Application:

- A detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants.
- Detailed publication list from 2018, including authors, titles, and journals.
- List of conferences that the candidate attended in 2018 as well as the research results presented.
- A scanned copy of the candidate's doctorate certificate.
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

The Award Will Consist of the Following:

- 1800 Swiss Francs.
- An offer to publish a paper free of charge, without a fixed deadline, in *Electronics*, after peer review in 2019.
- A certificate.
