A key factor limiting the expected development of the use of solar and wind energy is the availability of the minerals that are absolutely crucial to the production of wind turbines, photovoltaic cells, amd new generations of batteries, accumulators, and large-scale energy storage systems.

Demand for many of these minerals over the next 30 years may be 4–12 times higher than their current total production, which may be a significant factor limiting the development of the use of these leading renewable energy sources.
