Message from the Guest Editors

The Special Issue of *Energies*, on the subject area of “End-user Level Models for Enhancing the Integration of Renewable Energy Sources”, is now open to submissions. The goals set for achieving carbon-neutral power systems include, among the increased penetration of renewable energy sources and reduced greenhouse gas emissions, unlocking flexibility potential from the end-user’s side. The introduction of new market entities, such as aggregators and distributed sources of flexibility, results in more efficient power system operation, while energy communities and peer-to-peer trading directly contribute to the involvement of end-users in the low-carbon transition.
