We are pleased to announce that *Foods* is now inviting nominations for the 2022 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to a young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of food science and technology. All nominations will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Arun K. Bhunia.

The Prize:

- CHF 2000 (Swiss Francs);
- The option to publish one paper, after peer review, in *Foods*, with a 100% discount on the article processing charge within two years;
- An engraved plaque.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must be below 40 years of age or have received a Ph.D. no more than 10 years prior to 31 May 2022;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of food science and technology and the related fields;
- Must have been nominated by senior professors, research directors, or department heads.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists;
- Between three and five of the candidate's papers, nominated as most relevant to the scientific discoveries in terms of their applications (with an indication in a sentence or two as to why they are the most relevant).

Nomination Deadline: 31 May 2022

Please submit the nomination online before 31 May 2022. The winners will be informed via email and announced on the *Foods* web page by July 2022.
