Dear Colleagues,

Forest certification is one of the best-known voluntary environmental programs designed to demonstrate corporate social responsibility. While forest certification has become well established, scientific questions regarding its empirical impacts and effectiveness remain. Has forest certification improved forest management on the ground, improved social forestry processes, or enhanced economic returns compared to noncertified forests? This Special Issue will focus on research that assesses how professionals, certified forest land managers, and scientists can identify, measure, practice, implement, and evaluate whether forest certification is enhancing sustainability. Research articles should focus on empirical studies, using either primary field samples and data or secondary data and statistical analyses, in order to measure and evaluate the impacts of certified versus noncertified forests, based on ecological, social, or economic criteria
