# Can Managing Mixed Stands Mitigate Severe Environmental Change Impacts on Forests?

### Message from the Guest Editor

Currently, we are experiencing numerous severe environmental impacts on forests that are mostly related to climate change. In light of the threats to forests, it is necessary to undertake any possible measures that could be applied to maintain forests in a good condition.

Among many other solutions, shaping and maintaining mixed-species forests (MSF) appears to be justified in many cases and can be rationalized based on science.
