Composites from Recycled and Modified Woods – Technology, Properties, Application

Message from the Guest Editors

Recycled woods as well as thermally, chemically, or biologically modified woods have the potential to be a base or complementary raw material for (A) construction wood composites used mostly in construction and transport, such as glued prisms, glued boards, glued large-area boards from veneers, or large-area boards from wood particles and fibers, as well as for (B) decorative wood composites used mostly in furniture and building architecture, such as veneered, laminated, coated or plasma-treated large-area boards. For this Special Issues, we are interested in research on wood composites in the terms of the raw material conditions also encompasses technological processes, including finishing and surface treatments and their individual properties. Development of wood composites with special properties is also of interest. The papers should be focused mainly on material composition, processing, finishing, and properties of wood composites for construction and decorative purposes.

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
