We resort to approximate solutions in cases where analytical solutions are not adequate. One of these strategies consists of the use of iterative methods for solving equations and systems of nonlinear equations. The design and analysis of iterative methods for solving nonlinear problems is the subject of this Special Issue, as are their potential applications. In this sense, research on memoryless and memory methods, methods to find multiple roots, methods to simultaneously obtain all the solutions of a problem or methods using fractional derivatives, among others, are welcome.
