The Special Issue of *Geographies* aims to examine the scientific contribution of Early Career Researchers exploring all interdisciplinary aspects of the Geographical Sciences. Each manuscript will be peer-reviewed with at least two referees, in accordance with the peer review policy of the journal. Manuscripts are reviewed as quickly as possible, with an editorial decision usually reached within 3 to 4 weeks following submission. As this Special Issue is dedicated to researchers at the beginning of their academic career, it aims to make the publication process as transparent as possible and to give additional guidance on how to address reviewers' comments. Nonetheless, the research work will be assessed as rigorously as any other paper submitted to *Geographies*.
