In 2020 national healthcare systems were seriously challenged. The short-term, health-related consequences of the pandemic include increased mortality, physical and mental health issues, reduced access to medical care, challenges to hospital capacity and practices, and a need for new and radical practices for preventing the spread of the disease. However, increasing concern has been raised about the long-term health consequences.

This Special Issue will feature original research, reviews, short reports, and/or opinion pieces focused on 1) the direct and indirect effects of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic on physical and mental health (in both special clinical populations and the general population); 2) the impact of the pandemic on the accessibility and practices of healthcare services, with a focus on proposals for the implementation of new practices (such as telemedicine, telepsychotherapy, etc.); 3) the assessment and discussion of long-term outcomes in terms of health, healthcare, and broader socioeconomic consequences; 4) the effects of the pandemic on at-risk populations (such as older people, minorities, people with disabilities, and health workers).
