Message from the Guest Editors

Physiotherapy is the science that offers nonpharmacological therapeutic interventions aimed at preventing, treating, and alleviating the symptoms of different ailments. The objective of healthcare is to address chronic pain due to its high prevalence in the population. Physiotherapy has a fundamental role in the development of therapeutic strategies that improve the management of chronic pain: nociceptive, neuropathic, and nociplastic, offering better quality of life and functionality to those who suffer from them and helping to identify the personal impact of the disease. The advances offered by neuromodulation through noninvasive techniques such as transcranial magnetic stimulation and transcranial direct current stimulation are an alternative to pharmacological treatments to which patients do not respond adequately.
