Message from the Guest Editors

As a key contributor to metabolic diseases, the proinflammatory response is the focal point of the area of metabolic inflammation research. Particularly, children and adolescents affected by type I diabetes are exposed to a high risk of systemic complications and require multifactorial risk-reduction strategies beyond glycemic control. There are increasingly complex questions, with a need to leverage data to identify risk factors and potential correlations between type 1 diabetes in childhood and adolescence. This Special Issue focuses on high-quality research papers that address significant developments in the emerging knowledge about type I diabetes in childhood and adolescence. Suggested topics include: current concepts about the role of inflammation in diabetic children and adolescents: the development of new treatment strategies for type I diabetes; and the systemic effect of peripheral inflammation in pediatric diabetes.
