Musculoskeletal pain is a challenging condition for both patients and physicians. Many adults have experienced one or more episodes of musculoskeletal pain at some time in their lives, regardless of age, gender, or economic status. It affects approximately 47% of the general population. Of these, about 39-45% have longlasting problems that require medical consultation. Inadequately managed musculoskeletal pain can adversely affect quality of life and impose significant socioeconomic problems. This Special Issue will cover the pathophysiology, classifications, patient assessments, and different diagnostic and management tools of musculoskeletal pain. Special focus will be given to multimodal analgesia and multidisciplinary approaches that are fundamental elements of the effective management of musculoskeletal pain.
