# Mental Health Interventions for Children with Neurodevelopmental Disorders and Caregivers

### Message from the Guest Editors

Many advances have been made in recent years regarding early screening and diagnosis of children with neurodevelopmental disorders, especially autism spectrum disorder (ASD), attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), and intellectual disability (ID). In this Special Issue, we welcome original research articles, reviews of the literature (narrative review or systematic reviews—with or without meta-analysis), observational studies (cross-sectional and longitudinal), randomized clinical trials, and open clinical trials. Research areas may include (but are not limited to) the following:

- Studies evaluating the feasibility, effectiveness, or efficiency of mental health interventions for children with ASD, ADHD, and ID and their caregivers.
- Studies evaluating barriers and facilitators to educational or mental health services for children with these neurodevelopmental disorders and caregivers.
- Systematic (with or without meta-analyses) and integrative reviews on relevant and up-to-date topics regarding mental health interventions for children with ASD, ADHD, and ID.
