Message from the Guest Editors

It is our pleasure to announce the launch of a new Special Issue of *Healthcare* on "Strategies for Surgical Treatment of Colorectal Liver Metastases". Colorectal cancer is the second most common cancer among women and the third most common among men. It accounts for 10% of all cancer-related deaths globally, and about 25%-50% of patients develop colonic liver metastases (CRLMs). This Special Issue will focus on the different surgical options for the treatment of synchronous or metachronous CRLMs, which include parenchyma-sparing liver resections; minimally invasive surgery; the so called "liver-first approach"; two-staged hepatectomy; ALLPS; and more recently, liver transplantation. Ablation techniques will also be addressed in this publication, as they play a role in the multimodal treatment of CRLMs. We look forward to receiving your abstracts on these topics. A webinar involving the best experts in this field will be held on 18 November 2021 at 3 pm CET.
