2018 IJERPH AWARD FOR YOUNG INVESTIGATORS

Eligibility and Requirements:

- 1. Hold an earned Ph.D. or Sc.D. degree.
- 2. Be 35 years age or under (as of 31 December 2018).
- 3. Ground-breaking research conducted and a significant contribution made to the advancement of environmental science and public health research.
- 4. Priority will be given to applicants who have published papers in *IJERPH* in 2018.

List of Documents for Nominations:

- 1. Detailed curriculum vitae including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's research grants.
- 2. Detailed 2018 publication list including authors' names, title of paper, and journal's name, volume, and page numbers.
- 3. List of conferences the candidate attended in 2018 and the specific research results presented.
- 4. Scanned copy of doctorate certificate.
- 5. Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

The award will consist of:

- 1.2000 Swiss Francs
- 2. An offer to publish a paper free of charge without a fixed deadline in IJERPH after peer review.
- 3. An engraved plaque
