This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of environmental science and public health. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Paul B. Tchounwou.

The Prize:

- 2000 CHF (Swiss Francs);
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *IJERPH* after peer review in 2023;
- An electronic certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must have a PhD degree;
- Must be below 35 years of age by 31 December 2022;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of environmental science and public health;
- Must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

Nomination deadline: 31 December 2022. Winner announcement: 31 March 2023.
