We are pleased to announce that *IJMS* is now inviting nominations for the *IJMS* 2022 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to five young investigators in recognition of their excellence in the fields of biochemistry, molecular biology, molecular biophysics, biomaterials, and molecular medicine. Only one winner will be selected in each field. All nominations will be assessed by an evaluation committee chaired by the Editor-in-Chief, Dr. Vladimir N. Uversky.

The prize:

- CHF 1000 (Swiss Francs);
- A certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- PhD or above;
- Under the age of 40 by 30 November 2022;
- Must have produced groundbreaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of any of the following research fields: biochemistry, molecular biology, molecular biophysics, biomaterials, or molecular medicine;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior researchers, research directors, or department heads.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Cover letter indicating the award (choosing only one field from biochemistry, molecular biology, molecular biophysics, biomaterials, or molecular medicine) for which the candidate is to be considered;
- Detailed CV, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

Open for nominations: 15 February 2022;
Nomination deadline: 30 November 2022;
Winners announced: 31 December 2022.
