Hydrogels usually consist of three-dimensional matrices of hydrophilic polymers held together by chemical or physical crosslinks, or supramolecular assemblies of small amphiphilic molecules. The gelation process occurs in response to a physical or chemical stimulus, such as temperature, pH, electric or magnetic field, enzymatic modification, light, and others. Consisting of mainly water molecules, they represent a unique class of materials, with applications such as cell therapeutics, many cartilage/bone regeneration, sustained drug release and drug delivery systems, tissue engineering, and 3D bioprinting. Despite these great strides, there is still much more to discover in this area. This Special Issue is focused on the use of hydrogels in tissue and bone regeneration. Hydrogels are particularly suited for this purpose as their physical characteristics resemble that of the extracellular matrix, and as such they have found applications as an extracellular medium for cancer cells, stem cells, and neuronal cells. Research papers on the applications of hydrogels to other biomedical applications are also welcome.
