Message from the Guest Editor

Neutrophils are the first leukocytes recruited to infection sites. They are well known for their host defense activity; however, the physiological roles of neutrophils are not restricted to infectious diseases. Recent evidence has grown, suggesting the novel physiological roles of neutrophils in various conditions from steady state to various diseases. The unique niche of neutrophils in disease conditions comes from their functions resulting from activation. Furthermore, the existence of neutrophil heterogeneity in diverse pathophysiological conditions, similar to other myeloid lineage cells. Knowledge of the newly identified neutrophil population greatly contributes to our understanding of the functional roles of neutrophils in various pathological conditions. This Special Issue is focused on the new molecular mechanisms involved in the regulation of neutrophil activity, the novel physiological role of neutrophils in diseases, as well as the heterogeneity of neutrophils in diverse diseases. Manuscripts that provide such information will be welcomed.
