Molecular Pathology and Novel Therapies for Head and Neck Cancer

Message from the Guest Editor

The number of new cases of head and neck cancer has noticeably rapidly increased in recent decades, especially among young adults. This is not only associated with tobacco and alcohol consumption, but due to HPV infection emerging as an additional risk factor, defining a new subtype of tumor that is distinct from “conventional” HPV-negative ones. This Special Issue aims to expand the current molecular knowledge on treatment options and innovative approaches, one of the top priorities in the head and neck cancer field being to revert the obscure scenario of poor outcomes and improve patient survival. For this Special Issue, we welcome experts to contribute with review articles, clinical trial design and results, epidemiological data, bioinformatics and basic science information that can stimulate the critical discussion of the molecular pathology and novel therapies for head and neck cancers. Any *in silico* data or pure clinical results will need to be supported with experimental data and will not be considered for review on its own.
