Message from the Guest Editors

The scope of this Special Issue is, to provide insight into (i) the different facets of immunopathology supporting the phenomena associated with severe COVID-19, such as lymphopenia, impaired response to interferon, and "cytokine storm"; (ii) the immunoregulatory mechanisms addressed at controlling excessive inflammatory responses without excessively limiting the antiviral immune responses; and (iii) the differences in innate and adaptive immune responses between infected patients and vaccinated individuals, deciphering both immunopathology and protection signatures. This research will provide useful information to set up new therapeutic strategies and to develop new vaccines that prevent viral immune escape and the selection of new variants.
