Message from the Guest Editors

CNS injuries including stroke, traumatic brain injury (TBI), and spinal cord injury are among the most common causes of disability and death worldwide. In this Special Issue, we welcome the submission of research articles, short reports, case studies, and traditional reviews. The issue is a forum for scientific communications, evidence-based discussion, opinions, and perspectives on the latest advancements in the science of CNS injuries. We particularly encourage the submission of reports on molecular mechanisms, genetics, proteomics, metabolomics and biomarkers, studies of therapeutic interventions and re-purposing of drugs, CNS drug delivery, studies that address the use and limitations of current preclinical animal models, and recent advances concerning in vitro and organ-on-a-chip models. We will also consider submissions regarding early and late medical complications in CNS injuries (brain and spinal cord edema, impaired energy metabolism, neurodegeneration, neuroinflammation, deep vein thrombosis, pulmonary embolism, infections, etc.)
