Message from the Guest Editors

This Special Issue is devoted to gathering and dissemination of high-quality studies on natural products. All classes natural products from natural sources are welcome, including terrestrial and aquatic plants, animals, and fungi, provided they are not the established drugs such as known statins or antibiotics. The semisynthetic derivatives, products of biomimetic syntheses, and analogs of NPs are outside the SI scope. Papers involving new or less studied compounds/mixtures demonstrating high activity as well as novel properties of well-known substances are welcome. Any kind of bioactivity related to human health is within the scope, provided the reported potency was adequate and molecular mechanisms of action was addressed. Pharmacokinetic investigations on bioavailability of natural products from various matrices and various ways of administration are encouraged, too.
