All environmental factors that alter cell cycle gene expression, apoptosis, and DNA damage repair are tumor-induced risk factors, including food, natural and artificial radiation, chemicals, and viruses. Pure clinical studies are not within the scope of this Special Issue; however, clinical submissions with biomolecular experiments are welcome.
