### Message from the Guest Editor

This Special Issue is a continuation of our 2016 Special Issue, “[Lysosomal Storage Disorders: Novel Concepts, Therapeutic Aspects and Beyond](#)”. The purpose of this Special Issue is to summarize our current understanding about the molecular features of LSDs and the involvement of various cellular pathways, such as autophagy, neuroinflammation, microgliosis and signaling in their pathogenesis. We also highly welcome papers addressing the molecular aspects of current and prospective therapies for LSDs, as well as novel concepts and hypothesis about these disorders, including their connections to more common diseases, such as Alzheimer or Parkinson. However, papers addressing disease phenotypes or clinical studies without a clear molecular emphasis are not within the scope of this issue. We encourage the submission of review articles and original research papers.
