This Special Issue of Old and New Players in Inflammatory Disorders is dedicated to the memory of Dr. Nadia Ferlazzo. Inflammation participates in host defenses against infectious agents and injury, but it also contributes to the development of many diseases that collectively represent the leading causes of disability and mortality worldwide. The mechanisms underlying the inflammatory regulation of these disorders are not fully understood. The interplay of cells involved in the immune system and inflammatory mediators orchestrates molecular pathways that contribute to tissue injury, oxidative stress, remodeling of the extracellular matrix, angiogenesis, and fibrosis in target tissues.
