Cancer immunotherapy represents one of the most significant advances in oncology in recent years. Historically, breast cancer has not been regarded as a highly immunogenic tumour because of the low mutation rate of breast cancer genes and a limited ability to form tumour-causing neoantigens. However, a growing body of research has confirmed a strong link between breast cancer and the immune system. Aiming to expand the therapeutic index of IO in BC, numerous IO therapies are currently being investigated beyond the PD-1/PD-L1 axis, including agents that target CTLA-4, LAG-3, TIGIT, and ILT3.
