Message from the Guest Editor

Adipose tissue is not a passive reservoir for energy storage; indeed, it produces several adipocytokines that act on different tissues and organs. Adipocytokines have attracted increased attention when multiple and pleiotropic effects, in proliferative, inflammatory, and immune responses, show up. The involvement of adipocytokines in the abovementioned processes represents the starting point and the rationale for analyzing the involvement of adipose tissue in health conditions (e.g., different lifestyles, aging) and several diseases (e.g., metabolic diseases, malignancies, immune disorders). For this Special Issue, we invite you to contribute with either an original research article or a comprehensive review focusing on the role of adipose tissue or adipokines in the regulation of health and disease or deepening our understanding of the molecular aspects that link this depot of tissues with other organs.
