Message from the Guest Editor

We would like to invite you to contribute to a Special Issue on the topic of the cGAS-STING innate immunity pathway. The regulation of innate immunity is essential for host defence against viral, bacterial and mycotic infections, but may also play a role in allergic diseases. It would be of particular interest to obtain more detailed information regarding how pattern recognition receptors (DAMP and PAMP) interfere with or regulate cGAS-STING signalling and the innate immune response. Another point of interest is the existence of possible feedback mechanisms between the innate immune system and cGAS-STING signalling. This Special Issue will accept reviews and original research articles.
