Among them: cellular stemness, epithelialmesenchymal transition, extracellular matrix remodeling, adhesion receptors and proteolytic enzymes, growth/ chemotactic factors or inflammatory cytokines/ chemokines. Studies concerning possible inhibitors of the above-mentioned phenomena or molecules will be very welcome. We strongly hope that, as for the first part of the Special Issue, also the second one will provide useful information to understand and counter the cancer metastatic process.
