Message from the Guest Editor

Interleukin 22 (IL-22) is a cytokine that has great therapeutic promise. In the 20 years since its discovery, IL-22 has been found to play critical roles in maintenance of mucosal barriers, bacterial clearance, epithelial cell proliferation, and inflammation. The initial implications of IL-22 for psoriasis, atopic dermatitis, and cancer have led to clinical trials investigating the efficacy of inhibiting IL-22 in these disease processes. At the same time, administration of IL-22 is being investigated clinically as a therapeutic approach for COVID-19, alcoholic hepatitis, and graft versus host disease (GVHD), These dichotomous clinical approaches emphasize the great need to better understand the contexts within which IL-22 is pathogenic vs. beneficial. Therefore, this Special Issue welcomes original research and review articles regarding IL-22, the IL-22 receptor, and the IL-22 inhibitor (II22ra2) in the context of disease and recovery.
