Mesothelioma Heterogeneity: Potential Mechanisms

Message from the Guest Editor

Mesothelioma is a rare aggressive cancer developing from the mesothelium. Recent molecular analyses have defined four different types of mesothelioma on the basis of gene expression, and two molecularly-defined groups based on prognosis. This Special Issue explores potential mechanisms causing this heterogeneity. Announced papers will include heterogeneity sources: learned from experimental animal models; from 3D spheroids, in the NF2/Hippo pathway signaling; tumor microenvironment. We are open to suggestions which will cover other aspects contributing to heterogeneity
