Message from the Guest Editor

Tumour cell invasion is a key hallmark in primary malignant brain cancer in both adults and children and remains one of the most critical factors involved in therapeutic resistance and recurrence. Lacking somewhat in the literature is how components of the tumour microenvironment (which change during tumour growth and in response to therapy) work together to support tumour growth, resistance, adaptation and recurrence. The aim of this Special Issue is to bring together specific areas and provide a broad overview on the topic of “Microenvironmental Influences on Glioma Cell Invasion” in the context of cell to cell bidirectional and unidirectional communication, molecular/signalling drivers, immunologic perspectives, metabolic influences, physical/mechanical perspectives, flow dynamics (vascular and CSF), radiation and therapeutic effects, mathematical models, and future perspectives on translational considerations. In addition, the types or modes of tumour dissemination will also be a topic.
