On behalf of the Journal of Clinical Medicine (JCM) Editorial Team, we are delighted to present a new Special Issue on the topic of “Advances in Metabolic Myopathies”, Guest Edited by Dr. Massimiliano Filosto and Prof. Alessandro Padovani, from the Center for Neuromuscular Diseases, Unit of Neurology, ASST Spedali Civili Brescia, Italy. Metabolic myopathies are a clinically and etiologically heterogeneous group of diseases, including muscle glycogenosis, fatty acid-related myopathies, and mitochondrial respiratory chain defects. Their clinical spectrum is very wide and ranges from infantile-onset to adult-onset forms and includes fixed myopathies, exercise-related myopathies, and multisystem diseases. Diagnosing these disorders is often puzzling because of their heterogeneity and possible misdiagnosis. The present Special Issue aims to provide non-specialist physicians in myology the tools to suspect a metabolic myopathy and to know current and future therapeutic options.
